

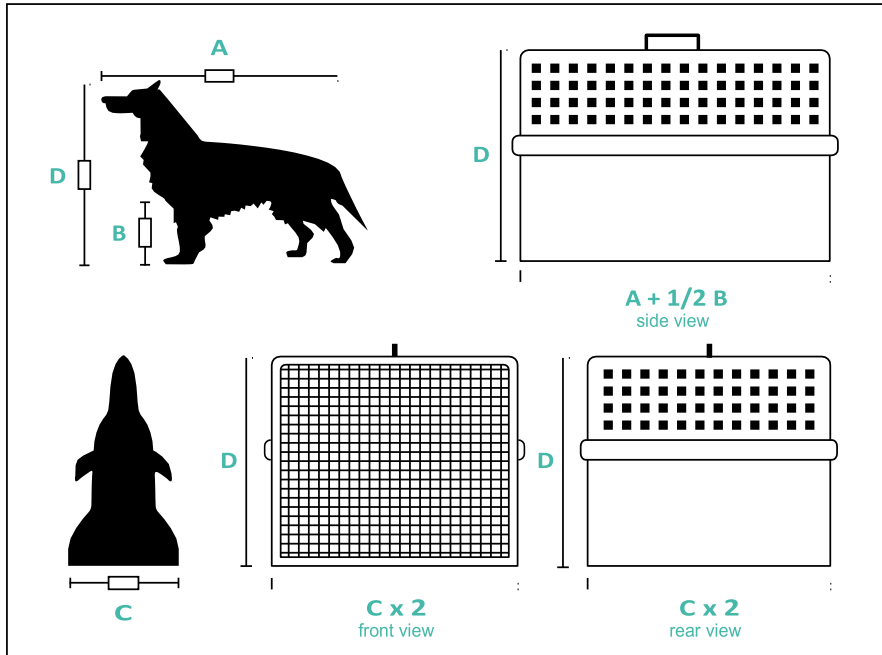


The Pet Porters

PET KENNEL CALCULATOR GUIDE

This is a mandatory requirement for cats and dogs traveling as cargo on TPP preferred, pet friendly, airlines.

Kennels not meeting these criteria on dimensions or meeting the IATA Live Animal Regulations requirements will be refused uplift.



INDEX

- A. From the tip of the nose to the root of the tail
- B. From the elbow to the ground
- C. The width at the widest point
- D. From the floor to the tip of the ears or the top of the head, whichever is higher

(Ears must not touch the top of the kennel in animal's natural standing position)

*Minimum internal box dimensions

- $A + 1/2 B = \text{Length}$
- $C \times 2 = \text{Width}$
- $D = \text{Height}$

*Snub nosed breeds require a 10% larger kennel

EXAMPLE OF KENNELS THAT ARE TOO SMALL FOR THESE DOGS AND THEREFORE REJECTED FOR TRAVEL.



EXAMPLE OF KENNEL THAT IS THE CORRECT HEIGHT AND LENGTH FOR THIS DOG AND ACCEPTED FOR TRAVEL.
